| 1. Candidato Viura <i>Spain</i>
<i>On the nose there are fruity notes of green apples, grapefruit and quince as well as strong floral notes. Silky and smooth on the palate with well- balanced flavours and a long finish.</i> | £3.25 | £4.25 | £5.95 | £16.95 |
| 2. Terres d'Azur Sauvignon Blanc <i>France</i>
<i>Zesty aromas of lemon, grapefruit and elderflower give way to a classically crisp palate with hints of white peach and a refreshing finish.</i> | £3.45 | £4.65 | £6.25 | £17.95 |
| 3. First Fleet Chardonnay <i>Australia</i>
<i>A delicious Chardonnay that captures the pioneering spirit of the first voyages to Australia in a crisp, modern style. Red apple and melon fruit fills a palate that is dry yet well rounded, making this a versatile accompaniment to food.</i> | £3.25 | £4.25 | £5.95 | £16.95 |
| 4. Poggio Alto Pinot Grigio <i>Italy</i>

| 5. The Swooper Pinot Noir <i>Australia</i>
<i>Pinot Noir is best known for its role in the classic red wines of Burgundy, but is now widely planted the world over. This example is full of ripe and juicy red berry fruit with soft, smooth tannins, giving a wine that is both delicious and easy drinking.</i> | £3.25 | £4.25 | £5.95 | £16.95 |
| 6. Terres d'Azur Merlot <i>France</i>
<i>Rich berry and plum aromas with hints of spice and chocolate lead on to a soft, smooth palate with generous fruit and smoky notes.</i> | £3.45 | £4.65 | £6.25 | £17.95 |
| 7. Valdemoreda Tempranillo <i>Spain</i>
<i>This smooth Tempranillo shows complex ripe fruit aromas with subtle spicy hints of vanilla and caramel thanks to five months in oak. Rounded and well balanced in the mouth with a full, long aftertaste.</i> | £3.25 | £4.25 | £5.95 | £16.95 |
| 8. Finca La Colonia Malbec, Norton <i>Argentina</i>
<i>Sweet and spicy aromas, reminiscent of black pepper. Ripe red fruit on the palate, smooth texture and a harmonious finish.</i> | £3.45 | £4.65 | £6.25 | £17.95 |

| 9. Golden State Zinfandel Rosé <i>USA</i>
<i>Fruity aromas and flavours of ripe red fruit, cranberries and watermelon. The palate has a gentle sweetness with a refreshing acidity that prevents it from becoming cloying.</i> | £3.25 | £4.25 | £5.95 | £16.95 |
| 10. Nina Pinot Grigio Rosé <i>Italy</i>
<i>With a delicate pale pink colour and an elegant nose of acacia flowers, this light-bodied dry rosé is delightfully refreshing.</i> | £3.45 | £4.65 | £6.25 | £17.95 |

WHITES

- 11. Featherdrop Sauvignon Blanc** *New Zealand* **£23.95**
Lively aromas of gooseberry, passionfruit, grapefruit and crisp red capsicum. Bold flavours of lemon, lime, grapefruit and gooseberry tantalise the palate and provide a refreshing clean finish.
- 12. Pecorino Vellodoro, Umani Ronchi** *Italy* **£32.95**
A refreshing, light-to-medium-bodied Pecorino, combining tangy green apple fruit flavours with hints of herbs, stones and almonds. The lively acidity lifts the palate, giving a finish that's as clean as a whistle.
- 13. Finca Montepedroso Rueda** *Spain* **£28.95**
A vivid expression of the Verdejo grape, with its characteristic notes of fennel, green apple, cut hay and peach, this wine is also imbued with an extra depth and richness in the mouth. A very satisfying, fuller-bodied style of Rueda.
- 14. Pouilly-Fumé Les Chailloux Silex, Chatelain** *France* **£38.95**
A lively, intense nose of green fruit, then focused mineral notes on the palate backed up by zippy citrus and some spice and mint flavours.
- 15. Sancerre, Domaine Cherrier** *France* **£39.95**
Fresh citrus on the nose, with a palate of melon and stone fruit balanced with subtle grassy notes and some bright minerality.
- 16. Petit Chablis, Brocard** *France* **£37.95**
White fruit and crystallized citrus aromas on the nose, then a lively palate with notes of flowers leading on to a slightly mineral finish.
- 17. Meursault Clos de la Velle, Darviot-Perrin** *France* **£80.00**
Refined Meursault with plenty of white peach richness, balanced by citrusy focus. Long and perfumed in the mouth – a great result from this excellent producer.
- 18. Babylons Peak Chenin Blanc** *South Africa* **£25.95**
A crisp yet generous Chenin Blanc, with tropical fruit character reined in by citrus and underlying mineral notes.

ROSE

- 19. Domaine Coste Rosé** *France* **£24.95**
Palish pink in colour, with a plump, dry palate and flavours of strawberry and blackberry. Fresh and round with good length.
- 20. Calafuria Negroamaro Rosato, Tormaresca** *Italy* **£37.95**
Peach petal pink in colour, this wine shows intense yet delicate fragrances of pink grapefruit, peaches and violets. The flavor is fresh and balanced with savoury notes and excellent aromatic persistence.
- 21. Minuty Prestige Côtes de Provence Rosé** *France* **£42.50**
Intense aromas of citrus and white flowers give way to flavours of grapefruits and red berries. There is texture and structure here and a saline, mineral streak running through the wine which gives substance and adds interest.

REDS

- 22. Visconti della Rocca Primitivo** *Italy* **£18.95**
Intense, fruity Primitivo full of jammy plum fruit and savoury spice. Smooth-textured with a lick of vanilla on the finish.
- 23. Niel Joubert Patrysbult Pinotage** *South Africa* **£19.95**
Smooth berry fruit with hints of banana and herbs leads to a medium-full, spicy palate with impressive balance and richness.
- 24. Bodegas Valdemar Reserva, Rioja** *Spain* **£36.50**
Complex aromas with subtle spicy notes and ripe black fruit touches, leading to a generous, intense palate full of plums, raisins and chocolate. Beautiful balance of fruit and oak, with a long, persistent finish.
- 25. Promesa Rioja Crianza** *Spain* **£25.95**
A classic style of Rioja, with strawberry, blackberry and rhubarb fruit flavours taking on a vanilla and cocoa smoothness during twelve months in oak barrels.
- 26. Santa Cristina Rosso, IGT Toscana, Antinori** *Italy* **£26.95**
Intense fresh fruit aromas with pleasant floral hints. Well-structured, generous and soft on the palate, with lingering fruit notes on the finish.
- 27. Château Mayne Vieux Castillon, Bordeaux** *France* **£26.95**
Plenty of depth to this Merlot heavy blend. Dark red fruits give way to prominent but soft tannins. There is just a touch of savoury earthiness on the well-balanced and well-rounded finish.
- 28. Fleurie, Flower Label, Duboeuf** *France* **£28.95**
Attractive scents of summer berries and spring flowers, with a wellstructured, medium-full palate.
- 29. Villa Antinori Chianti Classico Riserva** *Italy* **£46.95**
This is a rich, modern Chianti that marries beautifully ripe cherry fruit with well-judged smoky oak notes. The opulence on the palate is tempered by savoury notes of clove and a firm structure supporting the plump fruit.
- 30. Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine du Vieux Lazaret** *France* **£44.50**
A ripe, spicy blend with notes of vanilla and dark berry fruit. Full-bodied but elegant in the mouth, with a persistent juicy finish.
- 31. Langhe Nebbiolo Occhetti, Prunotto** *Italy* **£48.95**
This single-vineyard Nebbiolo offers an elegant nose with hints of raspberries and roses. On the palate, it is full and harmonious with a long, positive finish.
- 32. Wilyabrup Valley Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot, Woodlands** *Australia* **£39.95**
The nose shows dark cherry, blackberry, and plum combined with toasty French oak and hints of rum and raisin. The palate reveals layers of red berry fruits, with fine tannins and a refreshing finish.
- 33. Château Gaudin, Pauillac** *France* **£59.95**
This is a powerful, structured Pauillac with ripe cassis and plum fruit, emerging scents of tobacco and graphite, and the classic amalgam of weight and finesse.
- 34. Costasera Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, Masi** *Italy* **£80.00**
Bright and intense on the nose with aromas of preserved cherries and dried plums together with hints of fruits of the forest and cinnamon. Good weight from the alcohol and structured on the palate, opening out to attractive aromas of cherries and vanilla. Long, velvety finish.

SPARKLING



- 35. Prosecco Brut Itinera** *Italy*
With a bright, clear colour and fine persistent mousse, this Prosecco is harmonious and fruity, with a delicate flavour and a clean, crisp finish. **£24.95**
- 36. Prosecco Costaross** *Italy*
A classic Prosecco with aromas of white peach, pear and flowers. The palate is fresh, not too dry, and clean as a whistle all the way through to the sparkling finish. 200ml Bottle **£7.95**
- 37. Viticoltori Acquesi Rosé Brut** *Italy*
A beautiful pale pink colour, with a delicate aroma of spring flowers and orchard fruit, refined bubbles, and a crisp fruity finish. **£25.95**
- 38. Charles de Fère Blanc de Blancs Réserve** *France*
A pale golden colour, with fresh, fruity aromas of nectarine, melon and citrus. Elegant in the mouth, with fine bubbles, good complexity and a long, crisp finish. **£7.95 £34.95**

CHAMPAGNE



- 39. Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut** *France*
A perfect balance between power and finesse, its complexity comes from the predominant presence of Pinot Noir and Reserve Wines. **£64.95**
- 40. Laurent-Perrier Rosé** *France*
Consistently appealing, light and elegant with notes of red fruits and a delicate mousse. **£84.95**
- 41. Dom Pérignon** *France*
A mixture of 50% Chardonnay and 50% Pinot Noir grapes, this Champagne is light and warm on the nose, with aromas of white flowers and peaches. On the palate there are strong, clear peach flavours and a gentle smokiness that offsets its characteristic acidity. **£184.95**

SWEET WINES



- 42. La Fleur d'Or Sauternes**
An immediately inviting nose, combining apricot fruit, creamy patisserie notes and a certain citrus brightness, leads to a sweet yet beautifully balanced palate. Luscious but never cloying. **£ 7.50**
- 43. Morandé late harvest Sauvignon**
This wine combines flavours of honeydew melon and quince alongside an elegant floral burst of jasmine and orange blossom. The rich oily texture fills the mouth, but a cleansing and bright acidity stops this becoming cloying. **£6.95**
